### **Previous Minutes:**

Minutes from previous meeting to be accepted as read.

### **BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:**

- Decoration of four 6x3 Pavilions:  
Suggestions for decorating the pavilions should be sent to Liduina before the next Council meeting.
- Royal/Baronial Presence Pavilion:  
WIP - Ydeneya is still working on what she described as a very slow process which can also only be worked on by one single person, despite offers of assistance.
- Tent Poles for Baronial/Royal Presence tent:  
90mmx90mm poles needed. . . .Kane to organise. Expenditure for poles has been ratified at previous meeting.
- New Officers:  
A new Constable is required and the position has been advertised in both the Rhol and SCA website. Abertridwr has are 4 Constables at large but we need someone to take on this Office full-time.  
There is also a need for a Deputy Reeve and Deputy Seneschal. Karen has volunteered as Deputy Chronicler and Laurence as Deputy Chatelaine.
- Abertridwr T-Shirts:  
Orders can be placed with Kane with shirts costing \$26 each. Orders will need to be pre-paid.
- Fake tattoos:  
A cheque for \$320 + GST will be issued.

- **Coronets for Investiture:**  
Rhianwen has contacted Steveg who has said that he would loan his coronet for the Investiture. He added that as this was an important date in the calendar and that he would attempt to attend.
  
- **Calligraphied Scroll of Petition:**  
From an adult membership of 73, only 30 voted. The result of the poll was the outcome of 12 'yes' and '12 'no' votes for the Welsh wording and 12 'yes' votes and 9 'no' for the English wording with some members voting 'yes' for both versions. It was clear during the meeting that there was some confusion as to the purpose of the scroll and the vote has been declared nul and void.  
Alianore is to write her thoughts down to provide another option and Liduina will be sending an email identifying the use of the scroll.
  
- **Future Awards Structure:**  
Alessandra suggested the presentation of a red dragon scale for new comers and will forward her proposition in writing. Laurence stated having found a site listing all awards for various kingdoms and will forward the link to Kane.  
This item will be dealt with at the next meeting.
  
- **Chair Covers:**  
A workshop will be held after Easter and Liduina is to buy 20m of white heavy drill at the cost of \$8/M. The expenditure for the covering of the chairs has been previously approved at Council.
  
- **Arts & Sciences Judging:**  
To be be organised by Ilaria and Catalina at Pencampwr.

## **OFFICER REPORTS:**

### **REEVE:**

The balance of SCA Abertridwr #1 account as at 10/03/2013 amounted to \$4773.10 and that of SCA Abertridwr #2 account as at 10/03/2013, amounted \$7733.26

The Quarterly GST amount was in the negative for \$6.

The combined Corporate membership has triggered an audit flag with the ATO for accounts to be verified.

### **MARSHAL:**

Konrad announced that no-one had died and that there had been one new authorisation.

### **ARCHERY:**

Abertridwr has been looking into getting an easel type target stand, this is ongoing: No results as yet....

Lady Isabel of Target solutions has provided a price list of Archery equipment to pass on to those asking.

Lady Isabel has also agreed to come down to Abertridwr once a month to assist me with training when I am unavailable due to other interests.

Combat Archery targets:

There is Progress on the Targets and they will be ready to use soon.

Alianore has now taken the pieces home in order to complete them as there was no further time available at the end of last year.

Hope to start regular Combat Archery Training, alongside normal practice this year and maybe start a local IKCAC competition but under Lochac rules. Sir Peter D'Gaunt has offered his assistance in this but we need to authorise more Marshals and I need to get my own combat archery marshal authorisation done.

**HERALD:**

Karen Colli has been consulting Sir Kane regarding the Norse name of ‘Kolfinna Ráðulfsdottir’ as well as an appropriate device, both are being prepared for submission.

**CHATELAINE:**

On Sibilla’s behalf, Kane reported that the quote supplied by ‘Worldwide Print’ had been accepted for \$196 for postcards and \$111 for 500 Business cards. The expenditure was approved by Council and a cheque written for Kane to pay for the printing upon collection of the order.

Sibilla’s suggestion that items be donated and kept for demo purposes was strongly supported.
